We are looking for a communicative and team-oriented personality with a coaching degree / coaching licence (fencing epee), several years of professional experience and strong competence in competitive sports. The position is full-time (40 hours / week). The main place of employment will be at the High Performance Center in Potsdam and the position is initially limited until 31.12.2021. In the sense of a sustainable development, a long-term continuation of the employment relationship is sought.

Job Description

- Planning, organisation and management of individual lessons and training measures in fencing (epee) at national and international level for youth and senior athletes of the DVMF
- Training and supervision of the above-mentioned groups of athletes as well as active cooperation in the implementation of measures for the preparation of national and international training camps and championships as well as the corresponding qualification
- Training and competition supervision of the above-mentioned groups of athletes at the high performance centres and / or training centres; preparation of identified athletes for and competition supervision at competitions of federal interest
- Participation in the preparation of the framework training plans of the above-mentioned groups of athletes as well as coordination of the individual training plans in cooperation with the responsible home and base coaches
- Organisation of training camps and tournaments, coordination and monitoring tasks at the high performance centres and / or training centres in fencing (epee)
- Coordination between the DVMF and the participating clubs, regional associations, their training centres and athletes
- Supporting the Sports Director, the Head Coach and the Coordinators in the implementation of the annual planning (e.g. training camps, competitions)
- Constructive cooperation in the area of coach education and further education
- Participation in the DVMF's competitive sports committees
- Participation in the further development and implementation of the DVMF's concept of competitive sports

- Several years of practical coaching experience in the sport of fencing (epee) in the national and international arena (basic, follow-up and / or senior area)

- Preferably with own experience in the field of competitive sports
- Experienced in the organisation and implementation of training measures and competitions
- Experience in the field of performance diagnostics as well as imaging analysis techniques and training data documentation
- High digital affinity and experience in conceptual work
- High degree of self-organisation and the ability to solve problems in a structured manner
- Flexibility, high resilience, stress resistance and willingness to travel
- Excellent communication skills, strong negotiation skills, ability to work in a team as well as integration and assertiveness skills
